



#### China's GDP

# (billion US\$ at 2010 prices)






#### CHINESE MAN NUMBERS AND PROBABILITY OF THE GIFTED















#### FIGURE 1. REVIVING THE SILK ROAD












#### IQ distribution in China



About 91 percent of five-year-old Chinese design patents are discarded




