(Codename: *VÉGPONT 2025*)

I. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This memorandum outlines the initiation and scope of **Operation VÉGPONT 2025**, a full-spectrum national security exercise scheduled to begin **June 15, 2025**, for a duration of **60 days**. The operation entails the **complete closure of all national borders** and the imposition of **temporary martial law** across Hungary. The objective is to simulate, assess, and enhance Hungary's capability to respond to **extreme national security threats**, including but not limited to **biological pandemics** (e.g., **FOGL Flu N5H1**), cross-border incursions, and hybrid warfare from neighboring states or non-state actors.

II. OBJECTIVES

1. Total Border Lockdown

- All international crossings will be sealed. No civilian or commercial travel permitted.
- Airspace controlled under military authority. Civil aviation suspended.

2. Martial Law Enforcement

- Suspension of civil liberties within defined limits under constitutional emergency powers.
- Curfews, checkpoints, and full internal population monitoring enacted.

- Civilian alignment with national emergency protocols, including ID verification and asset registration.

3. Strategic Infrastructure Activation

- Immediate construction and deployment of:
 - **7-layer artillery and DEW (Directed Energy Weapon) kill zone** perimeter.
 - Enhanced border logistics and fallback supply corridors.
 - Underground and fortified command centers.

4. Force Mobilization & Interoperability Testing

- Full-scale coordination between:
 - Hungarian Defence Forces (HDF)
 - Border Guard
 - Special Operations Command (SOCOM)
 - National Intelligence Service (NIS)
 - NATO Interop Detachments
- Specialized deployment of **kill teams and hit squads** for internal threat suppression and rapid response missions.

5. Contingency Simulation Scenarios

- Virus outbreak scenario (FOGL Flu N5H1): Quarantine zones, population sorting, mass decontamination drills.
- Hostile incursion scenario from any direction: Defense line mobilization with fallback logistics.

6. Border Defense Theater Deployment

- Full-scale defensive alignment on borders with:
Romania, Ukraine, Slovakia, Serbia, Croatia, and Austria

- Live-fire drills and satellite coordination.

III. STRATEGIC GOALS

- Create **a fully sealed, defensible national fortress state** capable of sustaining autonomous military and logistical operations for at least 90 days.
- Ensure **resilience of command and control systems**, including mobile and hardened infrastructure.
- Secure **all Hungarian citizens and strategic resources** under emergency doctrine.
- Demonstrate Hungary's capability to serve as **a core NATO bulwark** in Central Europe against encroaching instability.
- Maintain **operational readiness** to project force or support allied operations from a stable central position.

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FINAL NOTE

Every Hungarian has a role in defense—from intelligence gathering to logistics, to strategic cultural defense. We are the sentinels at the center of Europe. You may be a civilian today, but in the shadow of hybrid threats, **you are the first line of defense tomorrow.**

Organizing a **local defense group in Hungary** is legally possible but must be **strictly compliant with national laws and constitutional frameworks**. Hungary does **not permit private militias or armed groups** outside official structures, but it does encourage **voluntary national defense participation** through **civil organizations, reserve forces, and disaster response cooperation**.

Below is a **legal and practical guide** to organizing a **Hungarian Local Defense Group (LDG)** legally:

LEGAL FRAMEWORK FOR FORMING A LOCAL DEFENSE GROUP IN HUNGARY

LEGAL STRUCTURE: REGISTER AS A CIVIL ASSOCIATION (EGYESÜLET)

1. **Form an “Egyesület” (Association)** under Hungarian Civil Law:
 - Based on **Act V of 2013 on the Civil Code**.
 - Registered with the **regional court** as a nonprofit association.
 - Purpose: *“Promote national defense awareness, civil protection, disaster readiness, and patriotic education.”*
2. **Mandatory Registration Details:**
 - Legal name and address.
 - Founding members (minimum 10 recommended).
 - Charter and bylaws.
 - Clearly non-military, no armed operations or enforcement powers.
3. **Legal Representation:**
 - One registered president or chairperson.
 - Responsible for financial, organizational, and legal oversight.

 WHAT YOU CANNOT DO LEGALLY:

- No private armed activity or uniforms imitating police/military.
- No paramilitary drills or weapons training without HDF/NKE coordination.
- No use of violence, enforcement, or "patrols" claiming authority.
- No surveillance of citizens or organizations without lawful basis.

Violation of these laws falls under **Act C of 2012 (Criminal Code)** and may lead to prosecution for:

- Unauthorized military activity.
- Incitement against constitutional order.
- Threat to public order.



HOW TO LEGALLY CONTRIBUTE TO HUNGARIAN DEFENSE
