




Affective Influence

Motivational Catalysts

Definition: Triggers that inspire effort and persistence (e.g., praise, curiosity, achievement). *Use:* Deploy strategically to enhance engagement and morale.

Narrative Intelligence Report

Definition: A personal reflection on a learning experience—how it felt and what was gained. *Use:* Builds self-awareness and solidifies long-term learning.

Neurodevelopmental Plasticity

Definition: The brain's capacity to form new connections and adapt—strongest in early childhood.

Use: Maximize through frequent, varied learning experiences.
